After exploring this temple ruin, your cultural journey continues with a short drive to nearby Preah Dak Village, a peaceful rural community nestled on the outskirts of the Angkor Archaeological Park. Here, you'll trade your vintage Jeep for a bicycle and take a gentle ride along quiet village roads, passing through beautiful rice paddies, stilted wooden houses, and rows of swaying palm trees. This part of the tour allows you to slow down and fully absorb the charm of the Cambodian countryside.

Next, visit a local home where you'll be welcomed into a traditional Khmer kitchen. Join a friendly village family and discover how to make Nom Banh Chok, Cambodia's beloved traditional rice noodle dish. Watch and participate in each step of the process—from grinding soaked rice to shaping and boiling the noodles. Then, enjoy the reward of your effort by tasting this delicious, freshly made meal, often served with a fragrant green fish curry and crisp local herbs.
